

XXII. FEDERAL RESERVE NOTES

Federal Reserve Notes form the largest issues of contemporary United States currency and are the only type of note issued in the present currency system. All denominations from 1 to 10,000 Dollars have been issued but only the 1, 5, 10, 20, 50 and 100 Dollar notes are still current. Notes of 500 Dollars and higher are no longer being printed. The notes of all issues of the 1930 series were redeemable in gold and the obligation on these notes is as follows, "The United States of America will pay to the bearer on demand..... Dollars ... Redeemable in gold on demand at the United States Treasury, or in gold or lawful money at any Federal Reserve Bank."

After passage of the Gold Reserve Act of 1933, paper money no longer became redeemable in gold. The obligation on succeeding issues of Federal Reserve Notes was therefore altered, and beginning

with the series of 1934, that portion pertaining to gold convertibility was amended to read as follows, "This note is legal tender for all debts, public and private, and is redeemable in lawful money at the United States Treasury, or at any Federal Reserve Bank."

Beginning with the series of 1963, the inscriptions "Will pay to the bearer on demand" and "Is redeemable in lawful money at the United States Treasury, or at any Federal Reserve Bank" were dropped. The obligation now reads as follows, "This note is legal tender for all debts, public and private."
